## OVERVIEW

- Component 2/ WG 2 aims to provide capacity building and technical expertise to the beneficiaries for:
  - preparation of waste management plans
  - development of policies and revision of legislation in line with EU waste priorities



## Assistance for the implementation of the roadmaps for improving waste management (TASK 2.1)

- Identification of needs of the beneficiary countries for further implementation of the roadmaps developed under the SEEWA project (report expected Nov 2019)
  - Consultations will be held individually with each beneficiary country



## Revisions of the waste management plans, policies and legislation, specific capacity building (TASK 2.2)

- ad hoc assistance, when/if requested by the beneficiaries and/or the EC, to revise waste management plans, policies and legislation via workshops, and/or expert missions (throughout the project life cycle)
- 2 capacity building subregional workshops (May and Sep 2020)
- 1 regional workshop to present the progress made by the beneficiaries in the implementation of the roadmaps (expected Nov 2021)



## Organisation of regional and national conferences on resource efficiency and circular economy (TASK 2.3)

- 1 regional conference on resource efficiency and circular economy (expected Mar 2020)
- 3 follow up national workshops on resource efficiency and circular economy (expected May and Nov 2020, May 2021).
  - The 3 countries where the national workshops will be organized will be selected as countries with advanced, moderate and weak knowledge of circular economy and resource efficiency in order to be able to understand the obstacles faced at each of the knowledge levels.
